

## **Seasonal residents and property owners CAN vote in Tiny Township!**

- Seasonal Property Ownership or tenancy in Tiny makes you eligible.
- You can vote in Tiny AND in your home municipality
- Own multiple Tiny Properties? You still only get one vote
- Your spouse can also vote – both spouses must register separately
- Voting is online and by telephone only
- A Voter Assistance Centre is available in person at the Township Office from October 13 – 26

### **1 CHECK YOU ARE ON THE VOTERS' LIST**

Go to [www.registertovoteon.ca](http://www.registertovoteon.ca) and search for your name using your Tiny Township property address

Not listed? Add yourself online – it only takes a few minutes

If you were registered in previous Municipal, Provincial or Federal Elections – don't assume you're registered for this one – check and confirm

When registering, use your Tiny Township property address (not your home city address)

### **2 REGISTER AS A NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY OWNER**

If Tiny is your secondary/seasonal property, follow the non-resident registration process at Elections Ontario

Full instructions at [www.tiny.ca/elections/voter-information](http://www.tiny.ca/elections/voter-information) (look for the secondary property instruction sheet)

Your spouse can also register – even if their name isn't on the deed

Your children cannot register unless they are over 18 and can prove permanent residency in Tiny

Deadline to register online is August 12, 2026 . After this date, contact the Township clerk to register

### **3 WATCH FOR YOUR VOTER INSTRUCTION LETTER**

Elections Ontario will mail you a Voter Instruction Letter (VIL) to your primary address in September 2026

It will contain your personal voter PIN. Keep it safe

No VIL has arrived by end of September? Contact the Township Clerk: 705-526-4204 or check [www.tiny.ca/election](http://www.tiny.ca/election)

### **4 Vote! – ONLINE OR BY PHONE, FROM ANYWHERE**

Voting is open October 13 – 26, 2026. You do NOT need to be in Tiny to vote

Use the secure online voting portal OR call the telephone voting number – both are listed in your VIL.

Voting closes at 8:00 PM on October 26 . Results will be announced that evening

| <b>August 12</b>     | Last day to register online at <b>registertovoteon.ca</b> . After this date, contact the Township Clerk.<br>No hard cutoff – but registration can take up to 5 days, so register early! |
| <b>September</b>     | Watch for your Voter Instruction Letter with your Pin to arrive at your primary residence                                                                                               |
| <b>October 13-26</b> | Voter assistance Centre open at Township Council Offices – staff will help you vote on-site.<br>There will be no paper ballots or polling stations, the voting will be done online.     |
| <b>October 12</b>    | Online and telephone voting begins                                                                                                                                                      |
| <b>October 26</b>    | Election Day - voting closes at 8:00 PM.                                                                                                                                                |

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### Frequently Asked Questions

- There will be no in person voting (paper ballots or polling stations) This election will be conducted entirely online and by phone voting
- If you were registered in previous Municipal, Provincial or Federal Elections – don't assume you're registered for this one – check and confirm. Some prior voters have found that they are no longer on the voters list.
- Please be prepared to have a piece of ID linking your name to your seasonal address, like a tax bill or hydro bill.
- You and your legal spouse can both register, even if their name is not on the deed.
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- Note that you must register separately
- Your adult children (18 and over), can only register to vote if your seasonal property is their primary residence. The owners of the seasonal residence may vote regardless of where in Ontario their primary residence is located. You can vote in Tiny as well as at your primary residence.
- You must register by August 18 to receive your Voter Instruction Letter and PIN (note this will come to your primary residence)
- The online registration process generally takes no less than 5 and no more than 20 minutes.
