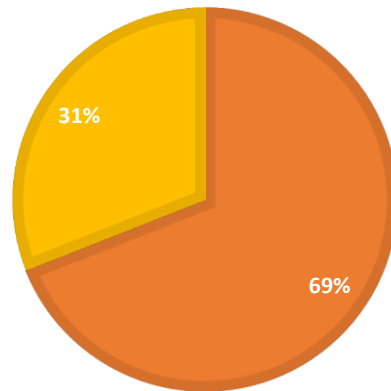


FoTTSA Boating and Swimming Safety Survey February 2019

- 376 responses total by Feb 10th: 322 via email (28% response rate) and 54 via weblink
- 182 written comments

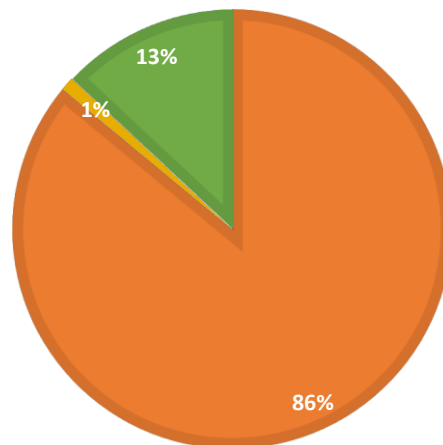
DID YOU KNOW ABOUT THE 10 KM/H SPEED LIMIT WITHIN 300 M OF THE SHORELINE?

■ No ■ Yes



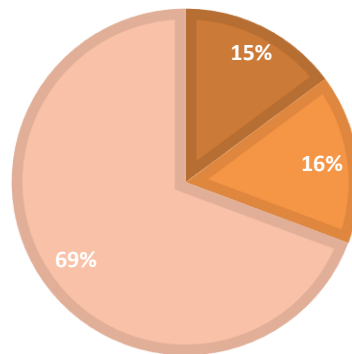
DOES YOUR BEACH HAVE SIGNAGE ABOUT THESE LIMITS?

■ No ■ Yes ■ I don't know



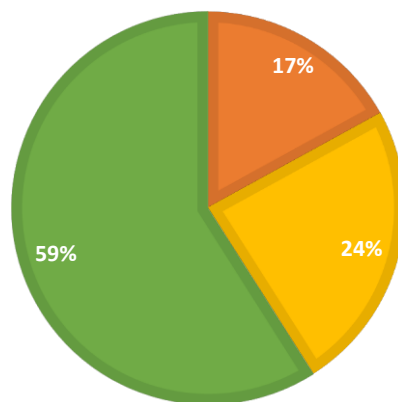
**ARE YOU AWARE OF ANY INJURIES OR NEAR MISSES

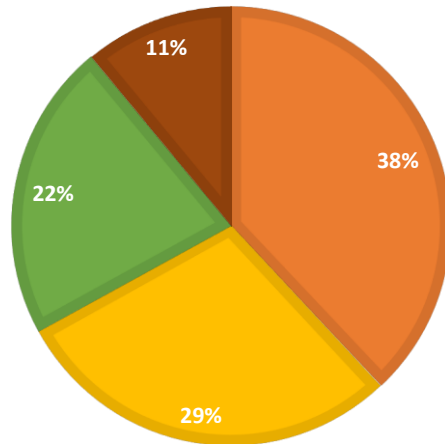
**ARE YOU AWARE OF CONFLICTS (E.G., HEATED

■ Yes, it happens a few times or more every summer ■ Yes, but it happens rarely ■ Not that I know of



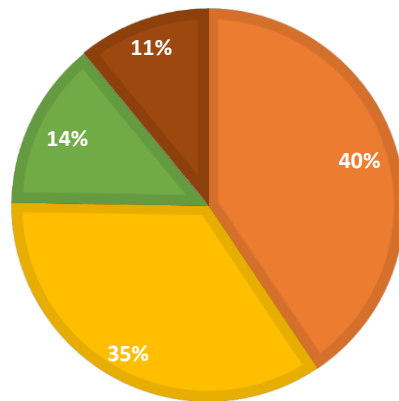

Very concerned Somewhat concerned A little concerned Not at all concerned



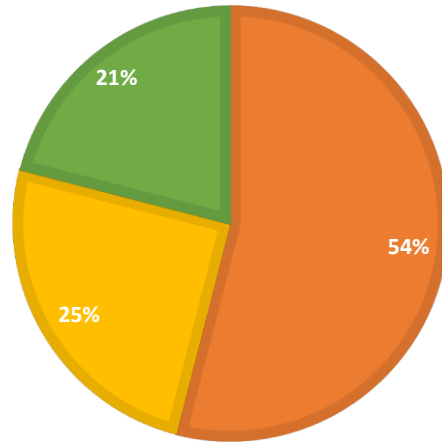

Top Written Comments

Suggestions for Signage - 107 mentions:

- at boat launch points
- Jackson Park
- at public beaches and right of ways
- at marinas
- at PWC rental locations
- at liquor stores

Need for Enforcement – 35 mentions

- Increased OPP presence on the water
- Possibility of anonymous/easier reporting to OPP/by law officer

Increased Public Awareness and Boater Education – 45 mentions

- printed info sent with taxes
- printed info sent with recycling info
- put info stickers on rented PWCs
- info in all local papers
- printed info delivered to each shorefront cottages
- info posted in all short-term rental units
- create a GPS app showing 300m line in Google maps

Top Concerns about Buoys and Signage – 32 mentions

- Price
- Not resilient enough
- Excess/ugly signage

Other related water safety concerns - 43

- PWC lack of respect
- Noise on the water
- Dangers posed by kitesurfing
- Dangers posed by power boats anchoring close to shore
